

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on October 10, 2022, at 7:00 pm. The meeting was rescheduled from October 3, 2022, due to quorum not being met. Member's present were Linda Dockter, Brian Thompson, and Dorian Beck with David Scholand presiding. The minutes from the September 4th meeting were read.

Public Works, Health & Safety:

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 ran 11 hours and pump #2 ran 11 hours. A motion by Brian Thompson to approve the consent agenda, was seconded by Dorian Beck, and passed unanimously.

Old Business:

A bid from Jeff Syverson with Valley Plains Equipment was presented for review to purchase a lawn mower. The mower is a 2019 John Deere Z994R, zero turn, 60" deck, diesel with a mulching kit. Dorian Beck made a motion to accept the bid from Valley Plains to purchase the mower. Linda Dockter seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

New Business:

Traill County EDC will be hosting a Community Showcase on November 10, 2022, at Goose River Brewing in Hillsboro. Information will be gathered to display at the event by David, Dorian, and Jen. A presentation will be made to the council at the November 7th meeting.

Linda Dockter made a motion to reduce the price of the 3 city owned lots without access to city sewer (far north side) to \$5,000 each. Also, the other city owned lots will all be reduced to \$20,000 each. Brian Thompson seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Dorian Beck made a motion to have Jennifer Skold as the point of contact and authorized signer with Vonesh Realty regarding the city lots. Linda Dockter seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by Dorian Beck, seconded by Brian Thompson, and passed unanimously.
