

## REYNOLDS CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Monday, October 5, 2020, at 7:00 pm. Members present were Dorian Beck, David Scholand, Linda Dockter, Brian Thompson with Lloyd Kennedy presiding. The minutes of the September 8, 2020 meeting were read.

### **Public Works, Health & Safety:**

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 ran 11 hours and pump #2 ran 12 hours. Water meters will be removed from the ball diamond and park shelter after October 19, 2020.

Motion by David Scholand was seconded by Dorian Beck to approve consent agenda items and passed unanimously.

### **Old Business:**

Motion to approve the final presentation of the 2021 Budget was made by Linda Dockter and seconded by Brian Thompson and passed unanimously.

Lagoon cell number 3 needs to be dredged prior to repair to the cell wall. Motion by Dorian Beck for Neil Breidenbach to dredge the sediment from the cell was seconded by David Scholand and passed unanimously.

### **New Business:**

Residents with past due utility bills were presented to the council. A motion was made by David Scholand stating accounts over \$200 will move forward with legal action. Residents that have an account balance of \$200 or greater will be processed through small claims court starting on November 1, 2020 unless agreeable arrangements have been presented and approved by the city prior to that date. Motion was seconded by Linda Dockter and passed unanimously.
