

The Reynolds City Council met in special session on October 8, 2022, at 7:00 pm for a Budget Hearing. Member’s present were Linda Dockter, and Brian Thompson, with David Scholand presiding. Guests in attendance were Liz and Jay Hildebrand. The Budget Hearing was called to order at 7:05 pm.

Mayor Scholand explained the increase in the budget is due to various factors. The park shelter has an outstanding loan for the renovation. The renovation was completed at the height of Covid causing rentals and donations to dry up. The city lawn mower is old, worn out and needs to be replaced. The city owned lots remain unsold and with interest rates rising a fixed rate needs to be locked in instead of only paying interest. In addition to those items, inflation is currently over 8% and is affecting a budget that has been historically lean.

Motion to adjourn by Brian Thompson, seconded by Linda Dockter, and passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:42 pm.
