

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Monday, November 2, 2020, at 7:00 pm. Members present were Dorian Beck, David Scholand, Linda Dockter, Brian Thompson with Lloyd Kennedy presiding. The minutes of the October 5, 2020 meeting were read.

The following bills were presented for payment: East Central Regional Water \$163.83, Menards \$61.92, Midco \$4.20, One Call Concepts \$1.20, Everett Severinson \$145.45 & \$13.72, Jennifer Skold \$719.92 & \$30.99, Traill County Sheriff \$46, Traill County Tribune \$79.92, Waste Management \$2,825.51, and Xcel Energy \$814.49

**Committee Reports:**

Planning, Zoning, Parks & Economic Development: A Traill County EDC grant was awarded and matched by The Reynolds Community Betterment to pay for the flooring in the park shelter.

Valley United Co-op submitted a request that was approved and matched by Land O' Lakes for a total of \$3,000. These funds are to help offset expenses on the park shelter renovation. Many of the planned fundraisers were not able to be held this year due to COVID-19.

**Public Works, Health & Safety:**

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 ran 12 hours and pump #2 ran 12 hours. Motion by David Scholand was seconded by Dorian Beck to approve consent agenda items and passed unanimously.

**Old Business:**

Letters were sent to residents with account balances over \$200 on October 14, 2020. Updated past due balances were presented. A motion was made by David Scholand to allow residents that contacted the city with payment plans to pay as arranged. The city will proceed with legal action for residents that did not respond to the letter. Motion was seconded by Linda Dockter and passed unanimously.

**New Business:**

A motion was made by Linda Dockter to accept the Grand Forks County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, was seconded by Brian Thompson, and passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Dorian Beck to accept the Traill County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, was seconded by Brian Thompson, and passed unanimously.

Larry Paul Linneman will be doing the snow removal for the city at the same rate as last season. He will also assume the city portion that was previously done by David Scholand. Motion to approve Larry as snow contractor was made by David Scholand, seconded by Linda Dockter, and passed unanimously.

A complaint was received stating a resident is putting their leaves in the ditch. A letter will be sent to the resident warning them it is against city code.

David Scholand made a motion to pay city utility bills with online bill pay to avoid late charges. Motion was seconded by Dorian Beck and passed unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by Dorian Beck, seconded by David Scholand, and passed unanimously.
