

The Reynolds City Council met in a regular session on November 6, 2023, at 7 p.m. Members present were Linda Dockter, Brian Thompson, Braden Majer, and Dorian Beck with David Scholand presiding. The minutes from the October 9<sup>th</sup> meeting were read.

**Public Works, Health & Safety:**

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: Pump 1 ran for 10 hours and pump 2 ran for 9 hours.

Linda Dockter made a motion to approve the consent agenda, which was seconded by Dorian Beck, and passed unanimously.

**Old Business:**

The generator for the sewer lift station was installed.

The current web host for the City of Reynolds web page has been sold and rates will be increasing in January of 2024. Several providers were researched and presented at the meeting. Braden Majer made a motion to accept the proposal from MunicipalOne at \$1,995 per year. The motion was seconded by Brian Thompson and passed unanimously.

**New Business:**

Surveying will need to be completed prior to connecting the roads in the new addition. The work is projected to be started in the spring of 2024.

The Beehive will be hosting a Bean Bag League again this winter at City Hall. They will meet on Thursday night starting November 30, 2023. The next City Council Meeting is December 4<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm. The City Council will sponsor and judge the Christmas Light contest in Reynolds on Thursday, December 7<sup>th</sup> at 6 pm. The 5<sup>th</sup> city-owned lot will close on November 7, 2023, with 4 remaining lots available for sale.
