The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Monday, December 6, 2021, at 7:00 pm. Member's present were Dorian Beck, Linda Dockter, David Scholand, Brian Thompson with Lloyd Kennedy presiding.

Public Works, Health & Safety:

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 ran 13 hours and pump #2 ran 14 hours. The second Biennial discharge report has been submitted to the Department of Health.

Bathroom stalls for the park shelter may need to be made instead of ordered. They will continue to explore options.

New Business:
