

REYNOLDS CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

The Reynolds City Council met in a regular session on March 6, 2023, at 7:00 pm. Members present were Linda Dockter, Dorian Beck, and Brian Thompson with David Scholand presiding. The minutes from the January meeting were presented.

The following bills were presented for payment: First State Bank \$508.24 & \$25; WinSupply \$146.73; Braden Majer \$110.82; Dorian Beck \$110.82; Midcontinent \$8.40; Xcel \$1,507.89; Waste Management \$1,856.54; Jennifer Skold \$719.92; East Central Water \$120; Traill County Sheriff \$250; Hillsboro Banner \$140.89; GovOffice \$570; Grand Forks County Highway Dept \$2,737; Jet-Way \$900; ND Sewage Pump \$400; Roto-Rooter \$295; Reynolds Fire Dept \$1,507.89; WSI \$250, and CV Post Prom \$250.

Public Works, Health & Safety:

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump 1 and pump 2 ran 8 hours each. A motion by Brian Thompson to approve the consent agenda was seconded by Dorian Beck and passed unanimously.

Old Business:

A generator is being researched for City Hall and the Fire Department. Randy with Interstate is working on bids for 2 generators. One will be located at the sewer lift station and the other between City Hall and the Fire Department.

New Business:

Linda Dockter made a motion to accept the maintenance agreement from the Grand Forks County Highway Department for one year of service. Braden Majer seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Inquiries will be made on an insurance claim for a sewer backup. Jordan and Abigail Adams closed on two of the city lots that were for sale on February 27, 2023. Spring cleanup will tentatively be scheduled for the first week of May. The City received funds from the Municipal Infrastructure Fund in the amount of \$43,468.64. Those funds are payments to non-oil-producing counties in ND. A tax equalization meeting will be held on April 3, 2023, at City Hall during the regularly scheduled council meeting.

Motion to adjourn by Brian Thompson, seconded by Braden Majer, and passed unanimously.
