

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Monday, April 4, 2022, at 7:00 pm. Member's present were David Scholand, Brian Thompson, Linda Dockter, Dorian Beck with Lloyd Kennedy presiding. The minutes from the March 14, 2022, meeting were read.

**Public Works, Health & Safety:**

**Old Business:**

A petition requesting vacation of the alley and street next to the Breidenbach property at 627 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue was received. Linda Dockter made a motion to accept the petition as presented to be published as notification of a public hearing. The motion was seconded by Brian Thompson and passed unanimously.

Information continues to be gathered regarding a purchase of a generator for the City Lift Station.

A second letter will be sent regarding the bus that is obstructing the view at 205 Hubbard Street. The bus is in violation of city ordinance and needs to be moved. If the bus is not moved by May 4, 2022, the City will tow the vehicle at the property owner's expense.

A letter will be sent inviting the property owner of 421 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the next city council meeting to discuss the abandoned trailer home on the property.

**New Business:**

The Franchise Agreement with Midco was presented for review as it expires in June of 2022. An inquiry will be made regarding negotiations of the current rate.
