

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, April 6, 2021, at 7:00 pm. Member's present were Dorian Beck, David Scholand, Brian Thompson with Lloyd Kennedy presiding. The minutes of the March 1, 2021 meeting were read.

Committee Reports:

Public Works, Health & Safety:

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 ran 13 hours and pump #2 ran 13 hours. A motion was made by David Scholand to approve the consent agenda and was seconded by Dorian Beck and passed unanimously.

Old Business: Discussion was held on the trailer house on Charlie Moen's property on the north side of Reynolds. Research will be done to see what options the city has to get the trailer removed and who the actual owner is.

New Business:

A building permit was requested by Travis Ripplinger at 318 8th Avenue to add a garage/shop on his property. The structure will be approximately 30' x 40' with 12' walls, vinyl siding and a steel roof. A motion was made by David Scholand to approve the building permit and was seconded by Brian Thompson and passed unanimously.

A second building permit was requested by Dave Flitter at 403 7th Avenue to add onto his existing garage. A motion was made by David Scholand to approve the building permit and was seconded by Dorian Beck and passed unanimously.

The note with First State Bank is due April 15, 2021 in the amount of \$31,656. David Scholand made a motion to pay \$5,000 from the money market account and \$5,000 from the Buildings and Grounds fund. An extension on the loan balance will be requested from the bank. Brian Thompson seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by David Scholand, seconded by Dorian Beck, and passed unanimously.
