

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Monday, May 2, 2022, at 7:00 pm. Member's present were David Scholand, Brian Thompson, Linda Dockter, Dorian Beck with Lloyd Kennedy presiding. The minutes from the April 4th and April 21, 2022, meetings were read.

The following bills were presented for payment: CV FBLA \$400; QuickBooks \$682.50 & 577.49; Janet Meyer \$1,500; Ferrellgas \$365.27; ND One Call \$2.60; Traill County Tribune \$237; Postmaster \$7.58; Xcel \$1,316.29; Waste Management \$1,788.37; Jennifer Skold \$719.92; East Central Water \$160; Traill County Sheriff \$250; First State Bank \$373.45 & \$2,500; Breidenbach Excavating \$1,993.95, and Job Service ND \$16.16.

Public Works, Health & Safety:

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 ran 61 hours and pump #2 ran 66 hours. A motion by David Scholand to approve the consent agenda, was seconded by Brian Thompson, and passed unanimously.

Old Business:

The Franchise Agreement with Midco was presented for review as it expires in June of 2022. A motion to sign the agreement at the current rate was made by David Scholand, was seconded by Dorian Beck, and passed unanimously.

New Business:

The loan agreement was presented for the park shelter to be renewed. Discussion was held regarding how much to pay down on the loan. David Scholand made a motion to apply \$10,000 to the loan. Motion was seconded by Linda Dockter and passed unanimously.

Drainage, culverts and standing water were discussed. Valley United Co-op hired Jetway to clean the culverts along Railway Street from 2nd to 4th Avenue. Larry Leiss expressed concern over the water standing on the city owned lot next to his property. Brian and Jordan Adams inquired about options for water drainage on the south side of the Beehive. Derry Meester joined in regarding the blocked culverts on Russell and 3rd Street causing water to seep into basements. More information will be obtained before any decisions are made.

David Scholand made a resolution to change the official newspaper for the city to the Hillsboro Banner. Brian Thompson seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

A donation request was received from Central Valley FBLA to attend Nationals in Chicago. David Scholand made a motion to donate \$400, was seconded by Dorian Beck and passed unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by David Scholand, seconded by Dorian Beck, and passed unanimously.
