

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Monday, May 3, 2021, at 7:00 pm. Member's present were Dorian Beck, David Scholand, Linda Dockter, Brian Thompson with Lloyd Kennedy presiding.

**Committee Reports:****Public Works, Health & Safety:**

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 ran 10 hours and pump #2 ran 10 hours. There was no discharge from November to March due to low levels of water. A motion was made by David Scholand to approve the consent agenda and was seconded by Linda Dockter and passed unanimously.

**Old Business:**

Research is being done to find the owner of the mobile home located on the corner of Sanborn and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

**New Business:**

A donation request was received from Central Valley High School for the Post Prom party. A motion to donate \$250 was made by Dorian Beck with Linda Dockter seconding it and passed unanimously.

A concern was raised about a resident burning rubbish within the City. A call will be made to the property owner to notify them of the issue. If the issue continues the City will proceed with action.

The roof on the restrooms at the city ball diamond need to be repaired or replaced.

A request was made to allow the Beehive Bar to close off Eagle Avenue (including a 1 block buffer zone on each side) to hold a street dance from 3 pm to 3 am on July 24<sup>th</sup>. Detour signs will be provided by Grand Forks County. David Scholand made a motion to approve the closure of Main Street for 12 hours, Dorian Beck seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

An inquiry was made by Vonesh Reality to purchase a lot in the new addition to place an existing home. The home did not meet the International Building Code and cannot be approved.

Motion to adjourn by Dorian Beck, seconded by Brian Thompson, and passed unanimously.
