

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, July 5, 2022, at 7:00 pm. Member’s present were Brian Thompson, Linda Dockter, Dorian Beck and Braden Majer with David Scholand presiding. The minutes from the June 6th and June 28th meetings were read.

Public Works, Health & Safety:

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 ran 56 hours and pump #2 ran 57 hours. Samples were submitted to Grand Forks Water Treatment to determine if two lagoon cells are acceptable for release. The State of ND has received the results and approval is pending. A motion by Linda Dockter to approve the consent agenda, was seconded by Brian Thompson, and passed unanimously.

Old Business:

Surveying will be done on select culverts to determine a scope of work.

Research is being collected on purchasing a lawn mower and will be presented at the August meeting.

Brian Thompson made a motion to approve the petition of vacation from Neil and Joy Breidenbach for the property south of 1st Avenue and east of Russell Street. The motion was seconded by Linda Dockter and passed unanimously. The streets and alleys on Lots 1 thru 6, Block 4 Leiss’s First Edition, Lots 1 thru 6, Block 5 Leiss’s First Addition, and NW ¼ Less Reynolds Townsite PC #2, 9.42 AC Tract & 3.80 AC Tract 1-148-51 A70.28 have been vacated.

New Business:

A motion was made by Brian Thompson to remove Lloyd Kennedy from all accounts at First State Bank and replace him with David Scholand. David shall have authority to sign all documents on behalf of the City of Reynolds. Branden Majer seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
