

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Monday, August 2, 2021, at 7:00 pm. Member's present were Dorian Beck, Linda Dockter, David Scholand, Brian Thompson with Lloyd Kennedy presiding.

Public Works, Health & Safety:

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 and #2 both ran 9 hours. The sample from the lagoon was approved and the cell was released. Valve 3 to the coulee has been replaced. A motion was made by David Scholand to approve the consent agenda and was seconded by Linda Dockter and passed unanimously.

Old Business:

Discussion of the rental agreement for the City Park and City Hall was tabled. More research needs to be done on plugged culverts and ditches. The subject was tabled until more information can be gathered.

New Business:

A preliminary budget for 2022 was presented for discussion and will be submitted to Grand Forks and Traill Counties for the August 10, 2021, deadline. Dorian Beck made a motion to approve the budget as presented by the auditor. Motion was seconded by Linda Dockter and passed unanimously.
