

The Reynolds City Council met in a regular session on September 11, 2023, at 7 p.m. Members present were Linda Dockter, Brian Thompson, and Dorian Beck with David Scholand presiding. The minutes from the August 7th meeting were read.

Public Works, Health & Safety:

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: Pump 1 ran for 12 hours, and Pump 2 ran for 13 hours. A new gate will need to be installed at the lagoon. Estimates were received to replace the gazebo in the park. The variation in the bids and the matching grant deadline caused the project to be revisited in January 2024. New swings and chains replaced old equipment in the park. The cement connecting to the park shelter was poured for the new storage shed. The new shed will be delivered on Tuesday. Brian Thompson made a motion to approve the consent agenda, which was seconded by Dorain Beck, and passed unanimously.

Old Business:

An update was provided regarding the sewer backup at the Riley residence. A second mailing of past-due letters has been sent to residents who have unpaid utility charges from 2022. They have been notified if the past-due charges are not made current by October 1, 2023, they will be applied to their property taxes as a special assessment. The generator for the sewer lift station should be delivered in mid-September.

New Business:

Fall cleanup day will be held on October 14th from 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

An estimate was received by a driver who damaged his running board when he hit the dirt on an open manhole cover. The city denied liability because the cone marking the hole was clearly visible.

Central Valley All-School Reunion Committee submitted a request for sponsorship for the 2025 All-School Reunion. Dorian Beck made a motion to donate \$500, which was seconded by Brian Thompson and passed unanimously.

A bid from Bobcat of Grand Forks was received for a Bobcat UW56. No action taken at this time.
