

The Reynolds City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, September 7, 2021, at 7:00 pm. Member's present were Dorian Beck, Linda Dockter, David Scholand, Brian Thompson with Lloyd Kennedy presiding.

Public Works, Health & Safety:

Sewer Report from Dorian Beck: pump #1 and #2 both ran 12 hours.

The siding and shingles need to be replaced on the shed in the park. Beck provided the material list and will purchase the supplies to complete project.

A motion by David Scholand to approve the consent agenda and was seconded by Dorian Beck and passed unanimously.

Old Business:

Online bill pay is in the implementation stage with the host of the City website. The rental agreement for City Hall was discussed and the small event fee was increased from \$50 to \$100.

New Business:

The loan for the new lots is due to renew with First State Bank. When the 2 pending lots close a plan will be made on how to restructure the remaining loan balance.

The paperwork was signed to be submitted for the American Rescue Plan Act for Cities.

Joy Breidenbach requested to continue with the process to vacate Russell Street south of 1st Avenue. The request was originally approved by Council on November 7, 2016.

Motion to adjourn by David Scholand, seconded by Dorian Beck, and passed unanimously.
